Design is only limited by your imagination and materials listed below.

- Cardboard: corrugated cardboard or carpet tubing. No waxed or treated cardboard. Exceptions are the paddles and decorations. Decorations are allowed and encouraged as long as they do not affect the structural strength or buoyancy
- Duct Tape: Any color, but boat must not be covered more than 50% in duct tape.
- Not Allowed: anything other than listed above. No wood, metal, plastic, staples, waxed cardboard, foam, inflatables, screws, etc. You are encouraged to paint your boat.

Propulsion (what make the boat move around in the water) paddles, oars, etc. No sails, motors, poles or ropes. Must be propelled by the crew on the boat, no help from outside sources or crew members outside of the boat.

Crew must consist of at least 2 humans. Crew must be inside the vessel; no pushing, pulling or swimming with the boat.

- All crew must be registered and signed in by 9:00 AM
- All participants must wear life preservers and shoes (water shoes or sneakers)
- No boat is allowed to have a closed cockpit or canopy or any other obstruction that would impede getting free of the vessel should it sink.

AWARDS:

Hydrofoil Award – This award is for the entry that goes the fastest/farthest in competition

Nautical Excellence Award - This award is for the best engineering/design entry

Flagship Award – This award is for the best appearance/theme

Titanic Award – This award is for the most dramatic/entertaining sinking

All boats must be removed at the end of the race.
